Information about cleaning – from Mr Crofts (Premises Supervisor)

The school have worked really closely with the facilities and health and safety staff from the Multi Academy Trust Central Team.

We have a really thorough risk assessment, which is available on the website for parents and staff to read through.

Here are some key points that should reassure parents that we have put in place additional measures to ensure health and hygiene in school:

- We have sanitiser stations in each class
- Teachers are regularly ensuring that children wash their hands
- We have purchased a high quality anti-viral cleaner product
 - o The microbe shield spray we spray on contact points (doors, handles etc) regularly, and is actually effective for 30 days after that
 - o There is 24 hours effective hand sanitiser that children receive each morning, in addition to the usual sanitiser throughout the day
- Bids are lidded to support the “catch it, kill it, bin it” approach.
- We have an additional portable sink should we need additional handwashing capacity.
- We have a “fogging” machine; we use this on a termly basis to release a special anti-viral compound into the school building. We do this while the school is closed.
