#### Bags, Coats and equipment

In order to minimise sources of contamination in school, children are required to keep to a minimum the things that they bring in from home.

Some children may need to bring in a packed lunch (named) and most children will bring in a water bottle (named) (see lunches and drinks for more information).

Children may bring in a coat to wear. This coat will be kept on the back of their chair during the day or on the peg in the EY unit. Children don't need to bring a coat if the weather is likely to be fine. All coats **must** be named. Children should take these home every night to allow us to clean the rooms.

Children don't need to bring any equipment into school. School will provide equipment in their own pack / drawer / organiser.

Children **must not** bring personal items (games, toys etc) into school.

Children will not need to bring a PE kit bag to school as they will wear their PE kit and trainers on their PE day.

Children will be allocated weekly reading book (s) and a reading record. These can be taken home to be read and signed (see home school reading). They will be given a plastic wallet to transport their books; they should make sure their books are in school on a Friday for changeover day.
